The Archives collection is comprised of annual conference journals, books, records of active and discontinued local churches, administrative documents, directories, newspapers, photographic and audio-visual materials, and ephemera documenting the history of the California-Pacific Annual Conference and all its antecedents. Subject areas covered by the collection include, but are not limited to conference government and infrastructure, church histories, pastors, and various conference agencies. The Archives, which is housed in the Claremont School of Theology Library's Special Collections area, is overseen by an archivist who reports to the Commission on Archives and History.
